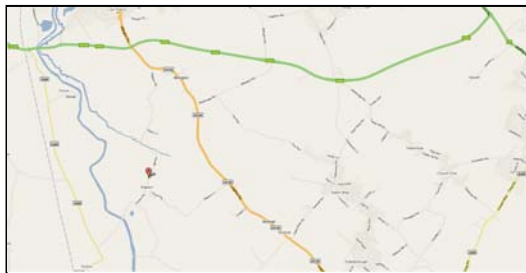


## Directions.

**From the North:** Take the A5 then the A505 towards Leighton Buzzard. You will reach a large roundabout (Mc Donald's & Total Garage) proceed left at roundabout, on the A4146 towards Hemel Hempstead. After approximately 500 yards turn right, towards Little Billington & Slapton. Continue on through the hamlet of Little Billington until you reach the village of Slapton. Immediately past the white border gates of Slapton Village turn right into Bury Farm.

**From the South:** Leave the A41 at the "Whipsnade / Tring" Junction and follow the B489 towards Ivinghoe, stay on the B489 through Tring and Bulbourne, straight over the roundabout and follow signs for Ivinghoe. You will reach the Kings Head Restaurant on your right, immediately turn right at this junction into Station Road, continuing along the B488 for approximately 2.8 miles, through the hamlet of Horton, (be careful of the speed restriction). Take the first right turn, signposted to Slapton. Follow the road through the village, just as you reach the outskirts of the village, Bury Farm is on the left.



## Show Rules

1. Closing date for pre-entries, seven working days prior to Show date.
2. Pre-entries to be accompanied by the appropriate fees.
3. Numbers will be available on day of show.
4. Suitable attire should be worn while showing. Jeans and trainers are not acceptable.
5. The organizers reserve the right to divide or amalgamate classes or change / replace judges where necessary.
6. The judge and organizers decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Secretary in writing within 10 minutes of the alleged incident.
7. Competitors who enter classes that may coincide do so at their own risk.
8. No refund of entry fees will be made unless accompanied by a veterinary certificate.
9. Registered Shetlands must not be shown clipped unless working (ridden or driven).
10. It is a condition of the entry that all Ridden competitors must be adequately insured against all third party risks. All persons entering the showground do so at their own risk. The organizers accept no responsibility for any loss, accident or injury to animal, person or property.
11. No entire males (excluding foals) to be shown by persons under 14 years old.
12. If in the opinion of the Judge or the show committee, an exhibitor or handler behaves in an unreasonable manner they will be required to leave the ring immediately. Similarly if the behaviour of a pony is considered to be unreasonable or dangerous it will be required to be removed from the ring.
13. Hard Hats must be worn when mounted on the showground.
14. Three year old fillies with foal at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of 3 weeks old on the day of the show.

Please note that there will be an annual general meeting of Chiltern Shetland Pony Group on the 15<sup>th</sup> October 2011 at the Redbourn Cricket Club, Redbourn, AL3 7DB commencing at 2.00pm and we also look forward to seeing you all at the show(s) in 2012
